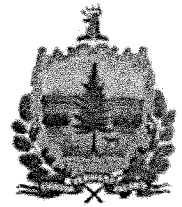

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) If not associated with a criminal complaint, service must be attempted by certified mail, return receipt requested before Law Enforcement will attempt to serve.
- 2) Complainant should be provided/take three (3) copies of order and fill them out. Do NOT sign any of the copies until in the presence of a Notary Public.
- 3) Mail one (1) of the copies by CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, to the person whom you want the warning issued. Keep two (2) copies in your possession at this time.
- 4) When the green CERTIFIED MAIL RECEIPT is returned to you by the Post Office, bring the receipt and an ORIGINAL signed copy of the Trespass Letter to the Sheriff's Office.
- 5) The Trespass Letter is considered to be in effect as of the time the original copy and the certified mail receipt are returned to the Sheriff's Office.
- 6) If the letter was not accepted by mail, bring the letter, Post Office documentation and the two remaining copies to the Sheriff's Office and an attempt to serve the paperwork will be made.
